Information regarding expenses for F-1 international Graduate students:

For all Graduate I-20s, Immigration Services uses the following living expenses for one academic year: **\$18,340.**

All I-20s require admitted international students to show proof of funding for one academic year.

The required Tuition & Fees, Living Expenses, and Other expenses are provided to students when requesting the immigration form I-20 in this format:
